**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR
THE GLEN @ HORIZON DRIVE CONDOMINIUM**

Notice is hereby given of the adoption by the Association of the following rules and regulations at it's Annual Meeting of Members held in June 5, 2002:

- 1. The provisions of Section 11.2a of the Condominium Declaration contained in Article XV thereof are supplemented by the following:

“Automobiles may be parked on Glen Court so long as the same vehicles that are currently registered and in regular use and not parked cumulatively for periods of longer than one (1) week at any given time. Recreational vehicles and/or trailers of any kind, shall not be parked, located or stored on the Common Elements for cumulative periods longer than two (2) consecutive days in any thirty-one (31) day period.”

- 2. Household Pets. The provisions of the Declaration are supplemented by the following as permitted by Section 11.6 thereof.

“Raising, breeding or keeping of any animal, fowl or reptile for commercial purposes is prohibited. Two (2) domestic household pets which shall not exceed forty (40) pounds each, or one (1) household pet not to exceed sixty-five (65) pounds are allowed in each unit, subject to rules and regulations adopted from the time to time. Pets shall be leashed when on the Common Elements. A Unit Owner shall immediately dispose of all refuse created by such Owner's pet(s). All Owners who closed upon title to a Unit prior to January of 2000 and currently own pets that meet the original guidelines as set forth in Paragraph 11.6 of the Condominium Declaration for the Glen @ Horizon Drive shall be permitted to keep those pets on the premises. All subsequent Owners and occupants shall be bound by these rules and regulations.”
